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Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this Set of Standards is to establish a framework that outlines:

- **1.1.1** The types of healthcare education & training programs that must be approved by DOH
- **1.1.2** The types of entities that can deliver healthcare education & training programs
- **1.1.3** Core requirements of healthcare education & training programs, providers and trainees

Note: This Set of Standards must be read in conjunction with all related Abu Dhabi & UAE laws, DOH standards, policies, and circulars, DOH Manuals, licensing regulations and reporting requirements.

		• Compliance: Fulfilling the legal and regulatory obligations by Healthcare Education & Training providers, programs and trainees
		• Quality: Critical features of Healthcare Education & Training settings and programs to be fit for purpose
		• Structure: Building blocks, resources and underlying elements, that Healthcare Education & Training settings and programs must have to ensure excellent education and training outcomes
2.9	Experience equivalency training	A time-limited supervised hands-on work placement offered to graduate healthcare professionals who do not fulfill the minimum number of years of experience stipulated in the current PQR licensure requirements– see Clinical Training.
2.10	<u>Fellowship</u>	A subspecialty training for graduated residents who wish to enhance their knowledge in particular area within their specialty. It consists of on-the-job training (usually for 1 or 2 years). An exit examination marks its completion.
2.11	Healthcare Education & Training (HCET)	An umbrella term that encompasses all education and training activities that healthcare professionals, students and graduate of medical or health sciences programs undertake to attain knowledge, skills, and competencies.
2.12	Healthcare Education & Training Provider	An entity approved to deliver education and training programs.
2.13	<u>Internship</u>	An Internship is a period of supervised training required for graduates following graduation to enhance and improve their competencies.
2.14	N/A	In the context of this set of standards, 'N/A' denotes an element that is not applicable
2.15	<u>Observership</u>	A time-limited period where an individual gets the opportunity to witness how health workforce members exercise their roles and responsibilities in the healthcare system without assuming any role in the delivery of patient's care.
2.16	Preferably	In the context of this set of standards, 'preferably' denotes an element that is optional
2.17	Professional training certificate program	An accredited structured, assessment-based training program in specific practice area, emerging technology, or new modality, for healthcare professionals to enhance or acquire new knowledge, skills, and competencies.
2.18	<u>Residency</u>	An on-the-job specialty training for graduates of medical, dental or other healthcare science programs (after obtaining

		a bachelor's degree). An exit examination marks its completion.
2.19	Return to Practice Training	A clinical training program offered to healthcare professionals who have an interruption of clinical practice (i.e. a discontinuity of practice) exceeding two (2) years and seeking to be licensed (PQR, 2022). see Clinical Training.
2.20	Undergraduate Education and Training Program	A time-limited supervised clinical clerkship that a student is obliged to complete as part of an undergraduate medical or health science educational program.

2.21 In the context of this Set of Standards "*must*" indicates a required element that has to be fulfilled, whereas "*should*" indicates an aspect that is recommended or preferred to achieve or implement but is not mandatory

3. Standard (1): Approved Practice Setting- Minimum Licensure Requirements

3.1. Healthcare facility wishes to deliver Healthcare Education & Training activity or program must first meet specific criteria to be licensed by DOH as an **Approved Practice Setting (APS)**. The criteria are listed in the following table.

3.2. Upon compliance with the listed criteria the healthcare facility must apply for DOH APS-licensure. The APS-licensure status requires renewal as follows:

- APS-Basic: annual renewal.
- APS-Intermediate: Every two years.
- APS-Advanced: Every three years.

4. Standard (2): Healthcare Education and Training Programs-Minimum Licensure Requirements

4.1. All Healthcare Education & Training Programs seeking licensure by DOH must meet specific criteria stipulated in the following table.

4.2. Education & Training Programs must be conducted in Approved Practice Setting⁶

4.3. The licensure status of an Education & Training program is linked to the APS- licensure validity status. Failure of the facility to renew its license or its APS- licensure would affect the program continuity.

4.4. DOH, may in its sole discretion and in consultation with stakeholders introduce certain caps on fees and charges imposed on applicants by Healthcare facility hosting Education & Training Program

4.5. Where accreditation of Education & Training programs is not mandatory (see Standard (1), criterion #15), the program must abide by DOH published standards and guidelines

This Standard covers the allocation of applicants to open training posts in the following Education & Training programs:

- a- Internship programs
- b- Residency and Fellowship programs

6.1. Allocation of applicants in programs must consider the following priorities:

- Emiratization Priorities
- Specialty preferences of applicants
- Fulfilling of specialty program requirements by applicants
- Number of training posts available in the program

6.2. Programs must be planed, governed, monitored and improved by DOH in collaboration with all respective stakeholders

6.3. DOH must grant a license to all health workforce enrolled in programs following the current PQR rules

6.4. DOH must establish organizational arrangements to address trainees' affairs and requests, including but not limited to grievances, requests of waivers and transfer to another programs

9. Monitoring and Evaluation

9.1. A monitoring and evaluation framework of key indicators is in place to evaluate the effectiveness, outcomes and impact of this Set of Standards, and where necessary adopt changes to ensure continuous improvement within the health system in line with emerging new developments in healthcare sciences, medical practices and healthcare education and training.

10. Enforcement and Sanctions

10.1. DOH must enforce the compliance of all concerned stakeholders with this Set of Standards

10.2. DOH must verify the compliance with the provisions of this Set of Standards through audit and inspection

10.3. DOH may impose disciplinary actions and monetary sanctions in relation to any breach of requirements under this Set of Standards in accordance with the Disciplinary Regulation of the Healthcare Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi
